

SPANISH 2 LECCIÓN PRELIMINAR MI MURAL PERSONAL



Murals or spray-can art have become a very important part of some urban Latino communities. These “free-spaces” provide places where community members can come together and show pride in their shared heritage and history. It also allows communities to highlight their concerns, values, and can help create solidarity within a community. A mural is any piece of artwork painted on a large permanent surface. A characteristic of a mural is that the elements within the space are harmoniously incorporated into the picture. For this project, you will create a personal mural. Use pictures, images, or symbols that represent things that are important to you.

You must include at least five different images. You may complete this task by drawing the images or using digital images from the computer. Your presentation of these images must be creative. The images and message should flow like a traditional mural. You will explain the significance of your mural in Spanish. Remember, you may look up SEVERAL individual words on wordreference.com, but translations of sentences will result in a grade of 0. Use words and grammar that you know.

1. Think of 5 symbols or images that represent you are as a person. (Part 1)
2. Draw or create a rough draft (Part II)
3. On a google doc, write 10-15 sentences in Spanish explaining your mural and what the images mean to you. Be sure to use correct grammar and spelling. Focus on the correct use and application of verbs like *gustar*, *ser*, *estar*, *tener*, conjugations, and stem-changing verbs. Also, adjective/noun agreement. (Part III)

Rough drafts should be shared with Profe Burke by **Friday, October 9th, 2015**. Finished murals and revised write-ups are due on **Tuesday, October 13th, 2015**. You will need to submit a paper copy of both your mural and your write-up.
