

Quien Es Description Project Rubric

In this project you will choose a picture of a person or several people and describe what you see. In your description you should include what the person or people look like, what they do or are currently doing, and state something about their personality. You will then choose 2 other similar pictures and include them along with the picture you described. Your project will be presented to the class and based on your description; your classmates should be able to guess who you are describing.

Your description project needs to be AT LEAST 6 sentences and include the following:

- 1.) At least two adjectives describing what the person or people look like.
- 2.) At least two adjectives describing the person or people's personality.
- 3.) Must accurately use the words "*porque*" and "*también*".
- 4.) Must include three pictures total.

Choose your pictures wisely and pay attention to noun-adjective agreement! BE CREATIVE!!! This should be fun. Use of a translator (as opposed to looking individual words up in the dictionary) will result in a project grade of 0.
