

# Final Project - Spanish 2

\*\*\* Please note all projects will be completed outside of class. Choose your project and your partner wisely! \*\*\*

## Option 1: Music Video

We have looked at a number of music videos to help you learn and understand Spanish. Now it's your turn! Choose a song that is 2-4 minutes in length. Create the new lyrics to teach a Spanish lesson that we have covered this year. It must be accurate and it must be school appropriate. Turn in your original lyrics. You may work in groups of NO MORE THAN 4. Each person must write a 1 page reflection in English detailing what was learned through the process and what the job responsibilities were. Have your lyrics on a flash drive or emailed to me using WORD so that I can post them and we can all sing along! Your final draft must be edited and ready to be presented by JUNE 3.



## Option 2: Painting

We have studied various artists and styles this year. Choose your favorite artist and one of their paintings. Recreate the painting as much as possible but incorporate a bit of yourself in the painting. Write a 1 page reflection in English detailing what was learned through this process. This is an individual project. Please include a copy of the original artwork. Your painting and reflection must be ready to be presented by June 4.




### Option 3: Board Game

Create a board game using knowledge that you have gained in Spanish 2. It could be a conjugating game, a trivia game, a drawing game, or a combination of all of them. You must create your board, its pieces, the concept and the rules. Write a 1 page reflection in English detailing what you have learned and what responsibilities you had. This may be done individually or in PARTNERS! Make sure your game rules are in English and that everyone can play the game. Please note in your rules how many players can play at once. Have your game and reflection ready to present on the day of your exam.



### Option 4: Children's Book

Write and illustrate an original story to develop a character and send him or her on an adventure. You may NOT use any words that you have not learned in class and you must use the past tense. Any translations will be automatically graded as a zero. Your book should be fifteen pages long with one sentence per page. Your illustrations must be done by hand, no computer print outs, or cut outs. Your book must be bound in some way. Have your book ready to be read to the class on the day of your exam.
