You will bring *una foto* or *unas fotos* of your family to class. This photo can be one that was taken recently or even from years ago. It can also be a fictional family picture taken from a magazine or even illustrated.

The picture(s) must include **at least 5 different family members (including you)!** In your project, you will need to provide the below info for each family member and yourself. You can also introduce family pets if they appear in the photograph.

1.) Introduction of family member:

- a.) Give their name in a complete sentence.
- b.) Relationship to you (*madre, padre, hermano, hermana*, etc). In mentioning each person, you should use the correct equivalent of “my” (mi/mis).

2.) Age:

- a.) Say how old each person is. Be sure to write out the age in WORDS!!!!

3.) Description:

- a.) Use at least three adjectives to describe the family member.
- b.) You should phrase adjective descriptions using sentences in **both the affirmative and negative**. *Por ejemplo: Aquí está mi hermana se llama Lisa. Es inteligente, pero no es egoísta.*
- c.) Be sure that your adjective agrees in both gender and number.

4.) Likes/Dislikes:

- a.) Write two sentences stating each person’s likes and dislikes. Remember to use the correct form of *Gustar*.

5.) Comparison:

- a.) Include a comparison to another person in your description of each family member.

Likes / Dislikes (Say what each person, including yourself likes and dislikes – 2 sentences per person)	Student accurately says what each person, including themselves likes and dislikes.
